The arena's reputation extends beyond its physical presence, as the term "Madison Square Garden" has become synonymous with significant sporting events and entertainment performances. It is one of the world's most famous and historically significant entertainment venues. Originally opened in 1968, the current Madison Square Garden is actually the fourth incarnation of the arena on the same site. We designed, engineered and installed over 16,000 linear feet of our incredible ornamental railing including: Track Rail™ guardrails with glass infill along vomitory entrances to reduce sight lines, marble topped beverage railing lining the perimeter of the bowl seating area, glass in suite areas with attached beverage rail and courtesy aisle railing throughout the facility. Our glass railing can also be found on the famous Chase Bridges which suspend over the fan seating areas.
