
Scope: St. Croix Central High School's theater in Hammond, Wisconsin, hosts roughly 15 concerts per year and a calendar of countless other events put on by both the school and the surrounding community. To help optimize the venue's acoustics, Sightline Commercial Solutions installed a Bravado® Acoustical Shell system, which features mobile towers comprised of movable panel wings that lock into place to make maneuverability simple for students. In the case of St. Croix Central, the customizable system includes seven acoustical towers and three ceiling rows. The ceiling panels are specially made to match the theater's aesthetic and feature a flexible design that lends itself to easy integration with the school's existing rigging system. Sleek casters and a convenient wheeled mover with a T-shaped handle allow students to move the panels on and off stage and easily position the system when reconfiguring it for different performance layouts.
