The Baker Center, a multi-tenant office property, includes four buildings located in downtown Minneapolis. The center had a unique art deco decor design that needed a light upgrade to bring in more light and energy. Sightline Commercial Solutions provided a dry glaze Track Rail system with glass infill to multiple stairs, overlooks and a rooftop terrace. Track Rail flows seamlessly from stairs to curved landing with a transition from straight to rolled top cap, cladding & shoe. This glass and stainless steel system added a touch of modern to this historic renovation. A highlight of this project is the curved landing which required rolled base shoe, cladding, top cap and glass to achieve the desired radius.



Track Rail features 1/2" clear laminated tempered glass and SGP interlayer, polished exposed edges and stainless steel top cap.



This curved landing required rolled aluminum base shoe, cladding, top cap and glass to achieve the desired tight radius.



Track Rail flows seamlessly from stairs to curved landing with a transition from straight to rolled top cap, cladding & shoe.



On interior stairs, stainless steel handrail was attached to 1/2" clear tempered glass with thruglass stainless steel standoffs.



The newly renovated seating area above the updated main lobby utilized Track Rail with formed top cap & 1/2" clear tempered glass.



Multiple stairs and overlooks utilized the Track Rail system with glass infill allowing light to flow throughout the lobby area.
