Scope:

Target Field is a state-of-the-art baseball stadium located in the North Loop neighborhood of Minneapolis, Minnesota. Opened in 2010, it serves as the home ballpark for the Minnesota Twins, the city's Major League Baseball (MLB) team. Target Field's new center field suite area includes a two level renovation with the upper level becoming Minnie and Paul's pub, while the mezzanine level transformed into the exclusive "Catch" suite area. Sightline Commercial Solutions provided custom glass railing, custom mesh railing, drink rail, aluminum perforated wall and stainless steel mesh partitions to complete this project.
