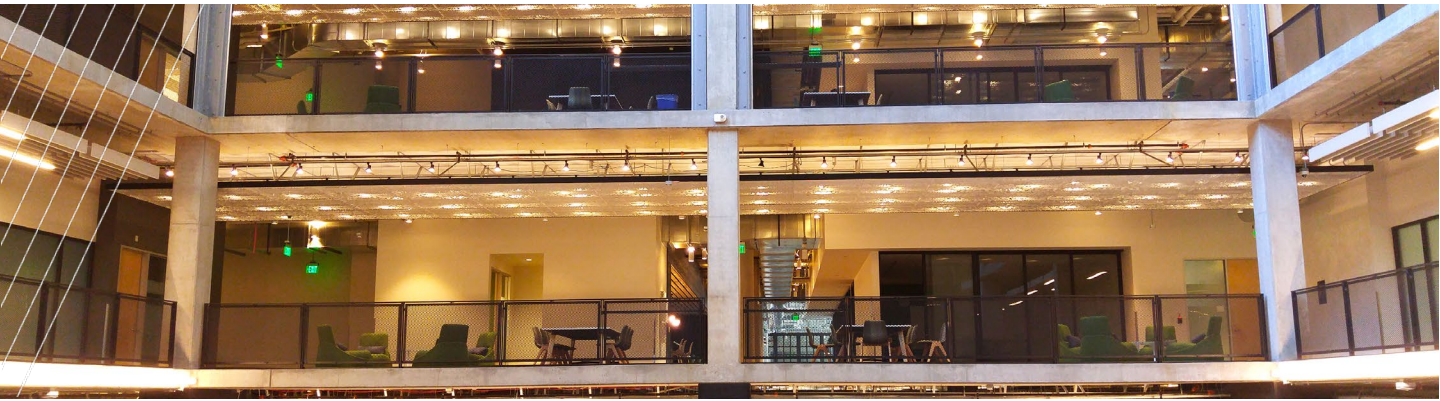

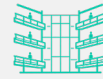

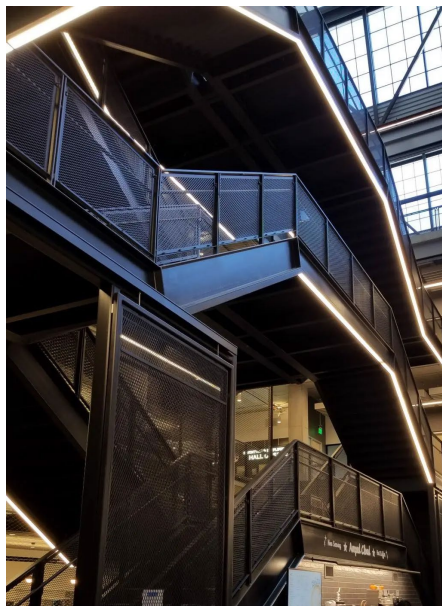

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Sightline custom engineered, fabricated and installed more than 1,200 linear feet of architectural railing throughout Amazon University, a 214,000-square-foot office complex in East Palo Alto, California. The railing extends throughout the building's four-story central atrium, including stairways, landings, overlooks and the ground-floor gathering area.

Designed to complement the building's open-concept aesthetic, the system combines Gridguard™ railing with custom diamond-pattern metal infill panels, integrated handrails and steel toe kick plates. The railing was coordinated to flow continuously throughout the atrium while providing safety-focused detailing at overlooks, landings and other elevated areas.
