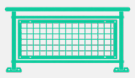

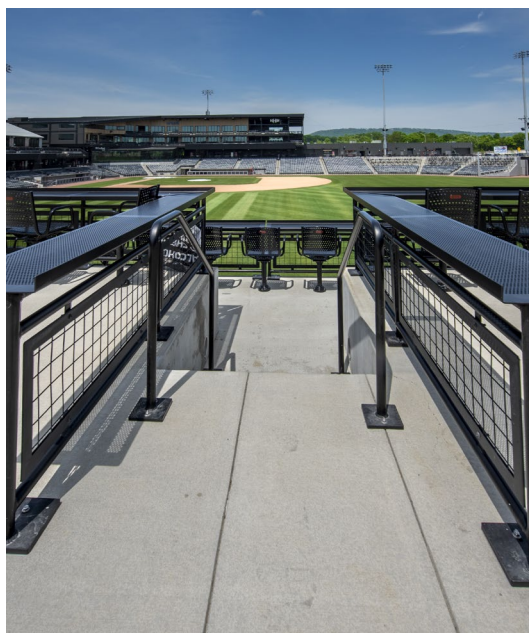
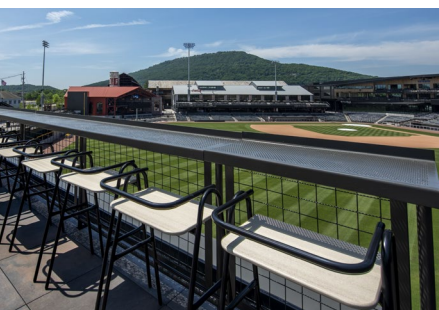

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Sightline fabricated and supplied approximately 8,800 linear feet of architectural railing systems for Erlanger Park, home of the Chattanooga Lookouts. The scope included black anodized guardrail, drink rail and aluminum pipe railing, along with matte black mesh infill and perforated drink rail tops that complement the ballpark's industrial-inspired architecture while supporting the modern fan experience.

Working within an aggressive 45-day production timeline, Sightline used 3D scanning to capture evolving field conditions and inform design as cast-in-place concrete work progressed. Close coordination between engineering and production helped maintain accuracy and keep materials flowing to installers throughout the compressed schedule.
